With two buildings, the district provides elementary and middle school education to Salem and the surrounding rural areas. Hawthorn, the district's elementary school, was originally built in 1970 at 33,860 sqft, and is home to 58 faculty members, and 385 K-3 students. The district's middle school, Franklin Park, was completed in 1979. At 82,940 sqft the school is geared to educate 554 4th – 8th grade students and 71 faculty members. Salem #111 is a district with goals to maintain their small-town roots with emphasis on education and athletics, while forging a path for their students to be active members of tomorrow's world with integrating the Arts and STEM initiatives.

- Address Aging Building Envelope
 - Replacement of exterior doors (13), and windows (48).
 - Repair masonry tuckpointing in critical locations.
- Pedestrian Safety Concerns
 - Add additional perimeter lighting.
 - Repair damaged sidewalks and pedestrian walkways.
- Internal Renovations
 - 63,000 sqft of acoustic ceiling tile replacement.
 - LED lighting upgrades in (6) classrooms.
