I would strongly encourage any reader of this letter who is looking for an Energy Services Company to consider working with Omni Energy Partners. Our Association recently completed a project with Omni, and it went extremely well.

Tazewell-Mason Counties Special Education Association (TMCSEA) serves 21 school districts across two counties in central Illinois. TMCSEA provides instructional and itinerant programs for member district students who attend their resident schools. Another purpose of the Association is to provide educational programming and services for member district students whose educational needs cannot be served within their local district. The Association operates Schramm Educational Center, a multi-faceted facility committed to providing high quality educational services to students ages 3-22 with significant disabilities.

In a limited summer timeframe (July 5th – September 4th, 2023), the dedicated team at Omni upgraded the school's HVAC system. We decommissioned outdated and oversized interior equipment and installed new, roof top mounted units that featured individual controls and improved air quality. Additionally, we replaced the entire ceiling grid within the walls of Schramm Educational Center, enhancing the aesthetic appeal and functionality of the spaces. Our school has a great deal of adapted equipment and furniture that had to be removed from the space and safely stored. Omni coordinated meticulous move-out and move-in processes, ensuring a seamless transition during the renovation. As a finishing touch, a comprehensive final deep clean was conducted to ensure a safe learning environment for students returning in the fall.

This is the first renovation project for me, and I greatly appreciated the support services that Omni provided. They listened to our needs, wants and special requirements; they tailored the solution to match our vision; and they kept me informed along the way. The whole project went very smoothly. They guided us through the entire process, and their collaboration and responsiveness were excellent.
